**PROCEDURE FOR ANIMAL CONTROL WITHIN AERO ACRES**

Your AAPOA Board of Directors (BOD) is constantly getting calls with regards to dogs running loose in our neighborhood. We all know there is a leash rule within our covenants and a St Lucie County ordinance.

It is impossible for your BOD to police the entire neighborhood.

Should you see a dog running loose in the neighborhood, please call "911" and ask for Animal Control, and the county will dispatch an Animal Control officer.

Pet owners first offense for leash law violation is a verbal warning, second offense a fine of \$100.00, and third offense is a \$200.00 fine.

Fourth offense for leash law violation is a \$400 fine and mandatory court appearance.

Please do not feel bad about contacting Animal Control. You are not the one breaking the rules.
