SANDHILL CRANES ON RUNWAYS AND TAXIWAYS CAUSING AVIATION HAZARD

It has been brought to the attention of the AAPOA Board of Directors that there has been an explosion in the population of Sand hill cranes on our taxiways and runways. Multiple aviators have expressed grave concerns regarding their presence in large numbers on the grass taxiways and runways posing an aviation hazard.

In response to discussion of this issue at AAPOA annual meeting, the BOD has directed all residents to stop feeding Sand Hill Cranes in order to reduce their numbers on the runways and taxiways and thus reduce the aviation hazard.
